









## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Australian consular services help Australians in difficulty overseas. Consular services can be accessed through the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate.

Make sure you take out travel insurance to cover hospital treatment, medical costs or medical evacuation, and that your insurance is appropriate for the types of activities you intend to undertake. Medicare and Australian private health insurance will not cover you outside Australia.

Read up on where you're going and know how you can access consular services. Travel Advice and Australian Embassy, High Commission & Consulate contact details are available on the Department's web page [www.dfat.gov.au/travel](http://www.dfat.gov.au/travel), or check your Hints for Australian Travellers guide.

Keep in regular contact with friends and relatives, and leave a travel itinerary with them.

Protect your personal information and make copies of your passport details, insurance policy, travellers cheques and credit card numbers. Carry one copy and leave a copy with friends or family.

Don't carry or use illicit drugs.

For longer stays in a country, or where the security situation is uncertain, register your details with the local Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate or online via the Department's web page [www.orao.dfat.gov.au](http://www.orao.dfat.gov.au)

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The loss, theft or destruction of this passport must be immediately reported to the passport office in your state or, if overseas, the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate.

This passport will not be extended in validity. You may apply for a replacement in Australia via the passports web page or, if overseas, at the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate.

You may enter personal particulars on the NOTICE page. Alteration to any other part may make the passport invalid and may make you subject to prosecution.

Children born abroad of Australian parents do not automatically acquire Australian citizenship. Applications for registration of birth should be made at an Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate.

Australian citizens who acquire the citizenship of another country from 4 April 2002 will not lose their Australian citizenship. If you acquired another citizenship prior to 4 April 2002 you may have automatically lost your Australian citizenship.

VISAS - It is the responsibility of the holder of a passport to obtain visas and permits. Some countries demand 6 months validity remaining on the passport before granting a visa.
